CHILD LIFE PROGRAM

Meeting the needs of the Child Life Program of the Pediatrics Department at UPMC in Central Pa.

NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

Supports the initiatives of Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP), a community health program that helps transform the lives of women who are pregnant with their first child by partnering mothers-to-be with a registered nurse to promote and teach positive health and attachment behaviors between a mother and her baby.

DIVERSITY EDUCATION AND TRAINING

REACCH GENERAL

Covers expenses for medical care, education, and support services offered through the REACCH program for people living with HIV/AIDS so that they may maintain optimal wellness, in addition to preventing HIV infections within our community.

WOMEN'S OUTPATIENT HEALTH CENTER

Covers expenses related to the Women's Outpatient Health Center, including education, the purchase of equipment and supplies, and patient care programs.



WOMEN'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Supports the Perinatal Wellness Program and women's behavioral health needs, as well as bereavement education materials for parents and staff education on perinatal loss.

LAWRENCE WIEDER NEUROSCIENCE

Used to enhance the quality of life and treatment for patients with neurological diseases and supports families of patients through efforts such as patient and caregiver education, community outreach, and case management.

CRIBS FOR KIDS

Promotes safe sleep habits and provides safe sleep education and materials, including cribs and sleep sacks for families in need.



ALEXANDER MEMORIAL

Supports cancer care services and support programs that address both the physical and emotional needs of cancer patients. including education, patient care programs, transportation, the cost of medications, and more.





SAFE PROGRAM

Provides assistance to nurses associated with the Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner Program through initiatives such as education for SAFE nurses, the purchase of equipment, supplies, and other needs of the program.



DIABETES MANAGEMENT

Provides services, including supplies and medications, to all patients of UPMC Central Pa. with diabetes so that they may maintain or improve their quality of life. This includes education, hands-on training, medical supplies, and diabetes research.

TRANSPLANT
